

Guidelines for Young Explorers

Adult Guides, please review these with your students.

- ☞ **Stay with your Adult Guide. The Adult Guides will have a map and schedules to help find and see everything.**
- ☞ **You and your Adult Guides are never to cross any barrier fence or attempt to touch any of the wild animals. They can all bite or scratch very hard.**
- ☞ **Stay on the paths. Be careful around the plants and trees. Many are sharp and some are poisonous. Do not eat fruit or any part of a plant.**
- ☞ **Take your time. Running is not permitted.**
- ☞ **Do not climb any tree.**
- ☞ **Straws are not permitted. Do not throw objects at any animal. Things like coins or rocks have blinded or killed animals. Such actions can lead to legal prosecution.**
- ☞ **Help your friends and everyone enjoy the shows and cruise. Be quiet or whisper and stay seated during these activities.**
- ☞ **Remember, this is the animals' home. Do not shout or scream.**
- ☞ **Recycle at the zoo. Please place aluminum cans and plastic bottles in recycling cans and trash in garbage cans.**
- ☞ **Zoo staff are happy to answer your questions. Ask them at the end of any activity.**

I have read and distributed the two guideline sheets to all Adult Guides for my group. The Adult Guides will review read their sheet and review the above guidelines with their Young Explorers prior to zoo entry and we will all abide by them. My group will be responsible for any and all damage caused by its members. I understand that members of my group may be asked to leave without refund if found risking the health or safety of plants, animals or themselves by not following these guidelines and may also be subject to prosecution.
