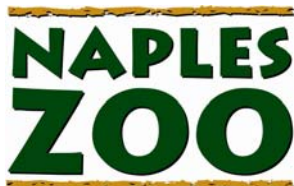

Visitors can also pick up a healthy lunch and snacks at the SUBWAY® Cafe and shop for wild gifts at tame prices in The ZOO Gift Shop. Pursuing its mission to delight guests with the wonders of the natural world to inspire the preservation of our planet's remaining wild areas and their wondrous inhabitants, the Zoo welcomes guests daily from 9:30 to 5:30 with the last ticket sold at 4:30.
